Chapter Volunteers Awards Policy

Approved: February 18, 2010

DEFINITION:

This policy defines the benefits Chapter award recipients will receive.

CRITERIA:

Nominees must be current members of the Chapter.

To be eligible for New Member of the Year, the nominee must be in the first full year as an Indiana member.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

At the annual spring institute, the Chapter gives two awards recognizing the volunteer efforts of its members.

Volunteer of the Year New Member of the Year

PROCEDURE:

January - The Board of Directors is asked to nominate members, with a brief description of why they are deserving of the recognition, to the Awards Committee for review.

January - The Awards Committee reviews the nomination and makes a recommendation to the Board of Directors for consideration at the winter board meeting. The Board of Directors approves the recommendations or asks the Awards Committee to make other recommendations.

April – The plaques are ordered and the awards announced at the spring institute.

POLICY:

The Volunteer of the Year will receive a certificate with a value up to \$850.00 to be used to attend a National HFMA meeting. The recipient must submit the Chapter's Expense Reimbursement Form following the meeting to receive reimbursement for registration fee and travel expenses up to \$850.00. The certificate will be valid for 18 months from the date of receipt.

The New Member of the Year will receive a certificate for a complimentary registration to a oneor two-day Chapter institute. The certificate will be valid for one year from the date of receipt.
